

Meeting called to order by Caroline Rediske.

No Public Comments.

Winter (Snowflake) decorations on County Road I: Caroline Rediske proposed purchasing 5 more snowflake decorations to go on the poles on County Road I to the bridge from Northern Lights Display for \$379.50 each. An additional five more snowflakes will be needed. **Motion by Vera Bollinger to approve purchase of snowflake decorations for \$2,000.00 from Northern Lights Display. Seconded by Faye Brittan.**

ATV's on trail system: No ATV's allowed on the trail system and snowmobiles are only allowed on the portion of the trail system designated for snowmobilers. Signs have been posted.

Pine Park Campground collection: The Park Committee approved the collection of campground fees by the Police Department since the Police Department will have part time police officers working 7 days a week this summer. There will be no park attendant on duty this summer. A suggestion was made regarding camping fees during the Freedom Festival. The camping fees could be collected with the ball tournament fee and then the camper would receive a wrist band to wear. Steve Williams will contact the ball tournament organization. The Park Committee would like to see improvements made to the rest room/shower room at the park.

Discussion was held on a donation box posted by the beach facing the boat landing. Is it allowed? More research will be done regarding a donation box at the boat landing.

Signage for beach and Pine Park: Campground signs will remain until the kiosk is in place in the campground. The committee approved more signage at the beach stating No Alcohol Allowed.

A miscellaneous project for Pine Park would be the purchase of an expression swing. Expression Swing is a Game Time exclusive and the industry's first playground swing that promotes intergenerational play as adults and children swing together. Estimated cost is \$1000.
