Meeting called to order by Chairman Kathy Poirier.

Discussion was held on a 221-1 Noise Ordinance Violation at 402 Courthouse Avenue. There were approximately 10 neighbors attending the meeting that reported a few of the items that are disrupting the neighborhood: tires squealing, loud music playing into the night, swearing, fireworks, littering, disrespect for neighbors and a large boat and trailer parked on the street at the intersection of Courthouse Avenue and Basil Street for the last 4 days (blocking the view to see when turning off of Courthouse Avenue onto Basil Street). The police department was called on Saturday night June 3, 2017 after receiving a call reporting a noise complaint at 402 Courthouse Avenue. The caller did not give out his name. According to the police no citations or warnings were given out as the caller was anonymous. After discussing the complaints the Committee members asked if the public would be willing to file any written complaints. They stated yes they would and they received Citizen Complaint forms. They will turn the forms into the Village Office at which time another meeting will be scheduled.
