Update on teleconference with Bakke Norman, re: rental property issues and trespassing.

Safety inspections on multi-family buildings are not allowed under our current ordinances. If an amendment to the ordinance is written & approved it would allow licensing and safety inspections to any new multi-family buildings. **Motion by Vera Bollinger to recommend to the board to contact Bakke Norman to write an amendment to the ordinance to allow licensing and safety inspections to multi-family buildings and to amend the Village nonconforming structure ordinance.
