

Meeting called to order by Faye Brittan.

No Public Comments.

The Village will receive a donation in honor of Fritz & Zilla Bibeau in the amount of \$350.00 to purchase a bench for Pine Park to be placed in the playground area. The Village will also purchase a bench. **Motion by Faye Brittan to approve purchasing a bench for the park playground. Seconded by Vera Bollinger. All in favor. Carried.**

Each softball team that will participate in the softball tournament held during Freedom Festival will pay \$50.00 for camping.

Review of the Outdoor Recreation Plan will be tabled at this time.

Faye spoke with the owner of Mosquito Maximus regarding spraying the beach and bridge area during the summer months. He reduced his normal fee to \$75.00 a month for the summer months of June-August. **Motion by Vera Bollinger to approve spraying the beach and bridge area this summer in the amount of \$75.00 per month. Seconded by Caroline Rediske. All in favor. Carried.**

Discussion was held regarding vehicles parking on the grass at Juneberry Park. Committee members understand that vehicles will park in the grass to get off the road, but do not understand why 2-3 vehicles deep would try to park in the grass. It clearly isn't a parking lot. Faye will contact Cody Korsan to discuss temporary barrier options. Members will also look into permanent landscaping barriers. The Police Department will fine drivers who break the temporary barrier.

Discussion was held regarding the Village dog ordinances. The ordinance does not directly state that a dog needs to be leashed at all times on the street or at public places or on a chain/leash in the yard of their home. Members will move forward with creating an amendment to the dog ordinance regarding enforcement of leashes. Police Chief Thompson will contact the Village Attorney for verbiage.

Motion by Caroline Rediske to adjourn. Seconded by Vera Bollinger. Carried.
