Ball Park Concession Stand Design, Size and Location: Keith Swenson presented information on a concession stand in Centuria. Discussion was held on the size, electrical and water/sewer hookups and amount of use. **Motion by Keith Swenson to table concession stand issue until more information is obtained from other groups involved. Seconded by Chris Sondrol. All in favor. Carried.**

Tennis Court Update: A bid in the amount of \$24,000 from Midwest Athletic Construction to repair the tennis court was reviewed. Discussion was held on the use of the courts and the expense. **Motion by Keith Swenson to delay a decision regarding repair of the tennis court and bring it before the Finance Committee for review at budget time. Seconded by Chris Sondrol. All in favor. Carried.**

Parks Overall Review: A complaint received from Joan Pike, property owner at 200 Pleasant Avenue regarding a secondary lake access on Pleasant Avenue was discussed. **Motion by Chris Sondrol to not upgrade or repair a secondary lake access at this time; priority to be given to primary accesses. Seconded by Keith Swenson. All in favor. Carried.** Discussion was held on Frisbee golf being played through campsites. Tom Thompson suggested doing something to better designate the camp sites. Discussion was held on creating a walking path under the power lines recently cleared by Northwest Electric on County Road I near the Thirsty Otter. Darryl Ince reported an issue regarding low water pressure at the American Legion building at Pine Park. **Motion by Keith Swenson to have maintenance work done on the piping at the American Legion building. Seconded by Chris Sondrol. All in favor. Carried.** Darryl Ince Informed the committee of updating the shrubs and plantings at the landing near the 46 Store.

Motion by Keith Swenson to adjourn. Seconded by Chris Sondrol. Carried.
