Discussion and possible action regarding Traffic Study results on Highway 46. Chair Corby Stark read communications from the state regarding the traffic study that was conducted in 2022. The decision in the report states, "to keep the speed limit as is". The communications noted the village could double up on "Reduced Speed Ahead" signage for southbound or upsize the first 45 mph sign for southbound traffic. In addition, the state was not able to find approved permits for the pedestrian ahead warning sign or the beacon, for pedestrian ahead warning signs. Motion by Aimee Newbauer to have Clerk Treasurer review the current permits for highway 46 to locate the missing approved permit applications. Second by Corby Stark. All in Favor. Carried. Steve Williamson also noted his concerns with the traffic study results and will look into other avenues for getting the speed reduced from 45 mph to 35 mph on highway 46.
